Dear Mr. Galitello:

Thank you for your letter dated July 11, 1994, to President Clinton seeking assistance to develop your company's high specific energy free piston engine-generator concept. I apologize for the delay in responding to you.

I regret you have had difficulties in reaching the appropriate organization within the Federal establishment. The Energy-Related Inventions Program at the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST), which falls under the auspices of the Departments of Energy and Commerce, was established by Congress specifically for the purpose of evaluating the many concepts and invention ideas we receive from the public. It is my understanding that your concept is currently being reevaluated by the NIST staff.

One of the unique features of the NIST evaluation system is that it was designed in anticipation that some technologies might not be fully understood, even by professionals in the field. The system allows the inventor to reenter the evaluation process by providing supplementary information addressing identified problem areas. I assure you that the NIST staff will provide you with an objective evaluation.


As another avenue for possible funding opportunities, you may want to obtain a copy of the annual publication, Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance, which lists and explains grant programs available from all Federal departments and agencies. The catalog is available for reference at many larger public libraries and most university libraries. It is also available by subscription from the Superintendent of Documents, U.S. Government Printing Office, Washington, DC 20401.

In addition, you might be interested in the Partnership for a New Generation of Vehicles (PNGV) program. Procedures for firms to compete for funds in the PNGV are outlined in the enclosed pamphlet.


Dear Mr. Lewett:
